Dear Parents and Carers,

We continue to ensure that we are following all Operational Guidelines set by the Department of Education to tackle the spread of COVID-19. Cleaning continues to occur throughout the day, including all touchpoints and the playgrounds.

A friendly reminder for all families. Students must not attend work or school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms must be sent home and not return to school unless:

- they have isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available
- they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free.

In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.
